Community College Classes:

- Take college level classes while in high school.
- Choose a class that is interesting to you!
- Choose wisely because this class will stay on your college transcript forever!
- Community College Classes are typically 5 weeks long, and meet Monday – Thursday every week. Morning and afternoon sessions are available. Online classes available as well!

How to Register:

- **Step 1:** Apply online at LACCD
<http://www.laccd.edu/Students/opencccapply/Pages/default.aspx>
- Student will receive a "Student ID" number 5-10 business days after application is processed via email.
- **Step 2:** Pick up a Concurrent Enrollment Form from a HTLA Counselor (Ms. Bender or Ms. Miramontes)
- **Step 3:** Fill out student information section and include "Student ID."
- **Step 4:** Look at the "Summer Schedule" online at the Community College of your choice, and list up to 6 classes that you are interested in taking.
- **Step 5:** Bring the completed Concurrent Enrollment Form to a HTLA Counselor for approval and signature.
- **Step 6:** Once the form is completed and signed, you must bring the form to the Admissions Office at the Community College of your choice for processing.
- **Step 7:** Check your email! You will receive an email letting you know when/how to go online and register for your class.

 - Student entering 11th/12th grade
 - \$250
- California State University, Northridge Summer Academic Enrichment Program
 - June 18th – July 20th
 - Grades 9-12
 - \$250 - \$725 (scholarships available)
- University of California, Los Angeles
 - Online Classes
 - Precollege Summer Institutes with on campus housing
 - Acting, art, digital filming, game lab, mock trial, writing, nanoscience, etc.
 - \$750 - \$2,000
