(Renewal Charter Petition for Citizens of the World 3) Recommends approval of the renewal petition with benchmarks for Citizens of the World 3, for 5 years, to serve up to 1070 students in grades TK-8 at the school located on three sites in Los Angeles, 11561 Gateway Blvd., 11500-11518 West Pico Blvd., and currently co-located with Webster Middle School at 11330 Graham Place.

(Renewal Charter Petition for Crenshaw Arts Technology Charter High) Recommends approval of the renewal petition for Crenshaw Arts Technology Charter High, for 5 years, to serve up to 600 students in grades 9-12 at the school currently co-located with Audubon Middle School, at 4120 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Los Angeles.

Charter Schools Division **Amended to Change Benchmark to add "English Learners" and Strike-out "All Students and for all of the school's significant subgroups".**  
(Renewal Charter Petition for Extera Public School No. 2) Recommends approval of the renewal petition with benchmarks for Extera Public School No. 2, for 5 years, to serve 432 students in grades TK-5 at the school currently co-located with Lorena Street Elementary School, at 1015 South Lorena Street in Los Angeles and with Eastman Avenue Elementary School, at 4112 East Olympic Blvd. in Los Angeles.

 Charter Schools Division  
 (Renewal Charter Petition for High Tech LA) Recommends approval of the renewal petition with benchmarks for High Tech LA, for 5 years, to serve up to 415 students in grades 9-12 at the school located, through a Facilities Use and Shared Agreement, on the Lake Balboa Education Complex, 17111 Victory Blvd. in the Lake Balboa area of Los Angeles
  
5. Board of Education Report No. 238 – 17/18 **ADOPTED AS AMENDED BY CONSENT VOTE**  
 Charter Schools Division **Amended to Add Benchmarks to provide a written status report to the Charter Schools Division annually no later than December 1, that provides evidence of its efforts and outcomes to increase student diversity for its student subgroup populations, including Latino students, Socioeconomically Disadvantaged students, English Learners, and Students with Disabilities, based on official student demographic information.**  
 (Renewal Charter Petition for Metro Charter) Recommends approval of the renewal petition with benchmarks for Metro Charter, for 5 years, to serve up to 365 students in grades TK-5 at the school located on two sites at 700 Wilshire Blvd. and 2009 West Martin Luther King Blvd., in Los Angeles.

 (New Charter Petition for Rise Kohyang Elementary) Recommends approval of the new petition for Rise Kohyang Elementary, for 5 years, to serve up to 569 students in grades TK-5 at the school to be located Board District 2 and Local District Central.
  
8. Board of Education Report No. 241 – 17/18 **ADOPTED BY CONSENT VOTE**  
 Charter Schools Division  
 (Renewal Charter Petition for Stella Middle Charter Academy) Recommends approval of the renewal petition for Stella Middle Charter Academy, for 5 years, to serve up to 750 students in grades 5-8. Currently the charter school is located on two sites at 2636 South Mansfield Avenue and through a Sole Occupant Agreement at 5431 West 98<sup>th</sup> Street in Los Angeles

 Charter Schools Division  
 (New Charter Petition for Valley International Preparatory High) Recommends approval of the new petition for Valley International Preparatory High, for 5 years, to serve up to 400 students in grades 9-12 at the school to be located in Board District 3 or 6 and Local District Northwest or Local District Northeast.

 Charter Schools Division  
 (Renewal Charter Petition for Valor Academy High) Recommends approval of the renewal petition for Valor Academy High, for 5 years, to serve up to 480 students in grades 9-12 at the school currently co-located with Panorama Senior High, at 8015 Van Nuys Blvd. in the Panorama City area of Los Angeles.

11. Board of Education Report No. 244 – 17/18 **ADOPTED BY CONSENT VOTE**  
 Charter Schools Division  
 (Renewal Charter Petition for ICEF View Park Preparatory High) Recommends approval of the renewal petition with benchmarks for ICEF View Park Preparatory High, for 5 years, to serve up to 600 students in grades 9-12 at the school located at 5701 South Crenshaw Blvd. in Los Angeles.

 Charter Schools Division  
 (Proposed Material Revision of Community Preparatory Academy to Add a Site) Recommends approval of the proposed material revision of the charter for Community Preparatory Academy to add a site in an area with materially different demographics than previously approved in the charter with the additional it located at 7019 South Van Ness Avenue in Los Angeles.
